What is the capital city of Wales?

Answer: Cardiff

Cardiff has been officially recognised as the capital of Wales since 1955.

Which river runs through central London?

Answer: The River Thames

The Thames runs through London before reaching the North Sea.

3

What colour is the cross of St George on the flag of England?

Answer: Red

The English flag is a red cross on a white background.

4

Which UK city is commonly known as the Steel City?

Answer: Sheffield

Sheffield is strongly associated with steelmaking and cutlery production.

5

Which is the largest country in the United Kingdom by land area?

Answer: England

England is the largest of the UK's four countries by land area.

6

Which London Underground line is shown in yellow on the Tube map?

Answer: The Circle line

The Circle line is represented by yellow on Transport for London's standard Tube map.

7

What is the official London residence and office of the UK Prime Minister?

Answer: 10 Downing Street

10 Downing Street is the Prime Minister's official residence and working office.

8

Which sea lies between Great Britain and Ireland?

Answer: The Irish Sea

The Irish Sea separates Great Britain from the island of Ireland.

9

What is the highest mountain in the United Kingdom?

Answer: Ben Nevis

Ben Nevis in Scotland is the highest mountain in the UK.

10

What currency is used in the United Kingdom?

Answer: Pound sterling

The UK's currency is pound sterling, usually written with the pound sign.
