**Which river is the longest in the United Kingdom?**

**Answer: River Severn**

The River Severn is generally recognised as the longest river in the United Kingdom.

**What is the Welsh name for Snowdon, the highest mountain in Wales?**

**Answer: Yr Wyddfa**

Yr Wyddfa is the Welsh name for Snowdon, the highest mountain in Wales.

**3**

**Which national park contains Scafell Pike?**

**Answer: Lake District National Park**

Scafell Pike, England's highest mountain, is in the Lake District National Park.

**4**

**What is the largest freshwater lake by surface area in the United Kingdom?**

**Answer: Lough Neagh**

Lough Neagh in Northern Ireland is the largest freshwater lake by surface area in the UK.

**Land's End is in which English county?**

**Answer: Cornwall**

**Answer: Glasgow**

**Answer: The Pennines**

**What is the central and largest island of Orkney called?**

**Answer: Mainland**

Mainland is the central and largest island in Orkney.

**Which island is separated from mainland Great Britain by the Solent?**

**Answer: Isle of Wight**

The Isle of Wight lies off England's south coast and is separated from mainland Great Britain by the Solent.
